- Liaise with and build relationships with academic editors, scientific associations, and other stakeholders, including by arranging and attending editorial board meetings

- Work with and build relationships with business partners, including distributors, library consortia, discovery and indexing services, platform providers and other suppliers, and industry bodies
- Meet financial targets and budgets
- Work with stakeholders to increase visibility, citations, and representation in indexing services of the journals
- Expand and adapt the existing portfolio in light of current developments in the journals ecosystem, including by transitioning journals when appropriate from German to English and from hybrid to open access
- Follow developments in research funding and science publishing, especially open access and open science mandates, publishing workflows, identifiers, technologies, etc., and apply this to ensure sustainable development of the journal portfolio
